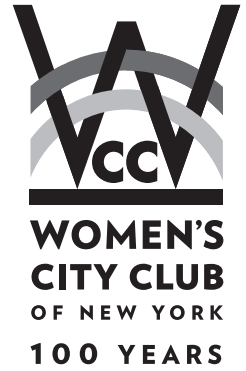

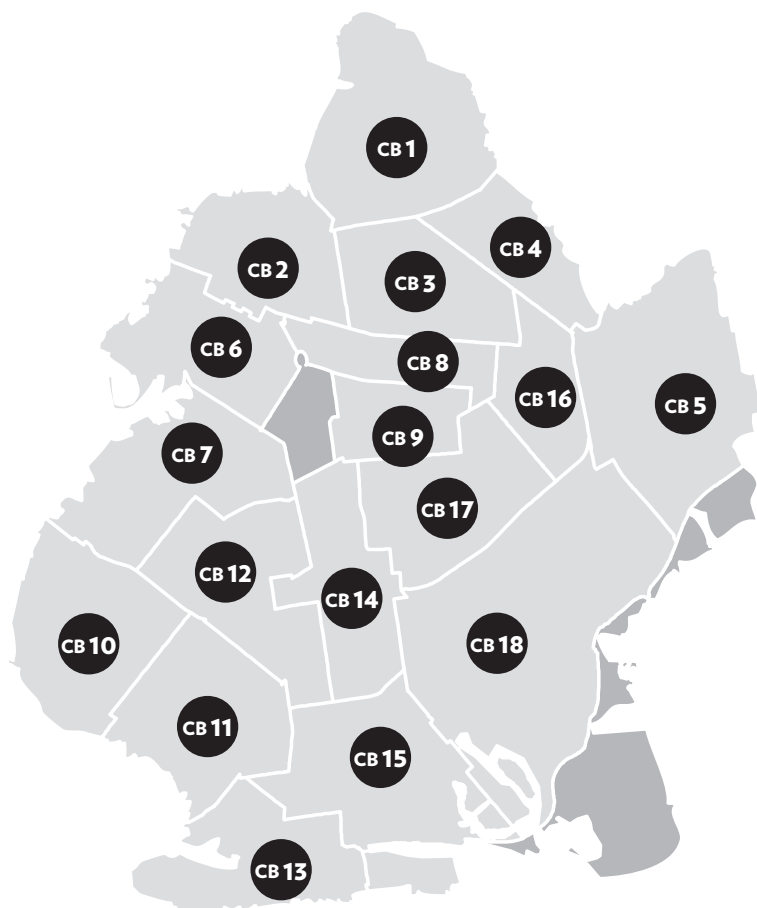

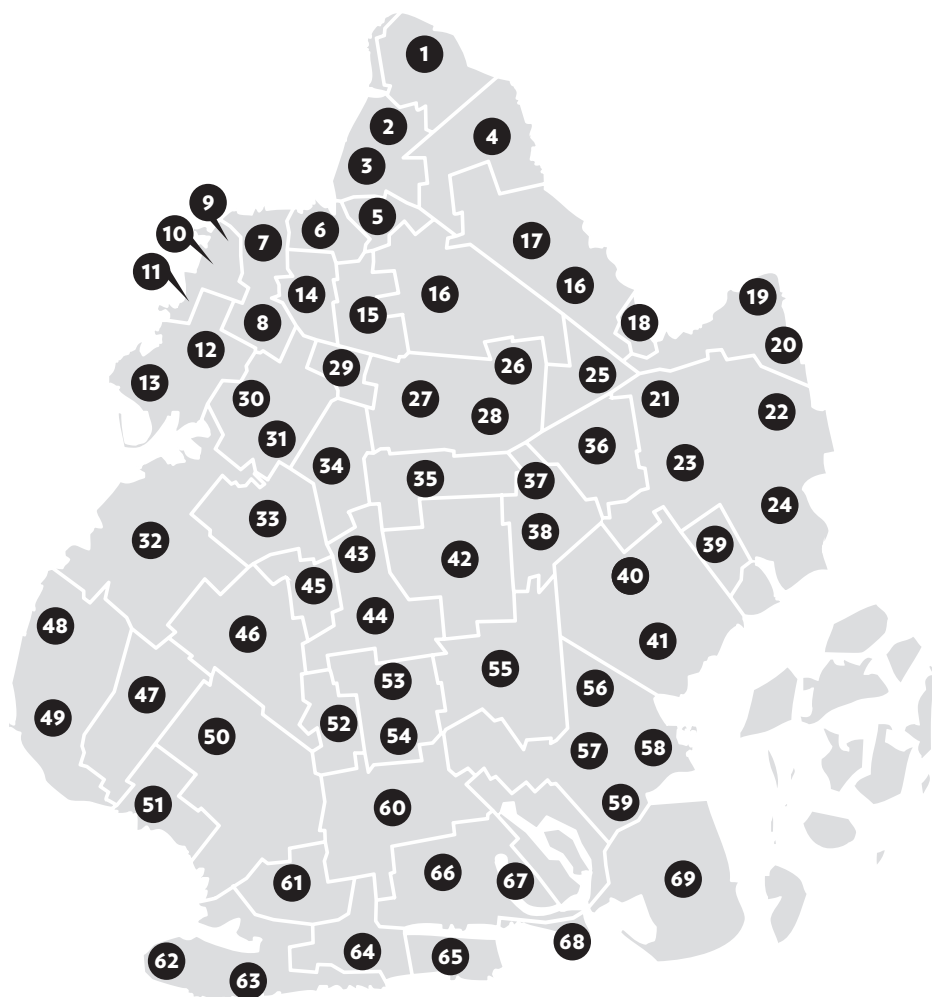

I. AFTER-SCHOOL PROGRAMS

After-School Programs provide childcare for elementary and middle school youth at hours when students are not in school and parents are not at home. They offer academic, social, and recreational activities and are sometimes referred to as “extended day” programs or “out-of-school-time” (OST). The resources in this category are listed separately under headings for academic enrichment, arts, and sports.

PROGRAMAS EXTRACURRICULARES

Los programas extracurriculares brindan cuidado infantil para los niños de primaria y escuela media cuando no están en la escuela y cuando sus padres no se encuentran en casa. Ofrecen actividades académicas, sociales y recreativas. A veces se los nombra como programas “de día extendido” o “periodo fuera del horario escolar” (“out-of-school-time”, OST). Los recursos de esta categoría se registran por separado bajo los encabezados de enriquecimiento académico, arte y deporte.

II. DOMESTIC & GENDER-BASED VIOLENCE

Domestic and Gender-Based Violence is violent or aggressive behavior within the home, typically involving the abuse of a spouse or partner. Further, this violence may be directed towards an individual specifically because of his/her gender. Resources in this category are listed under child abuse and incest, counseling and support groups, legal services, rape and sexual assault, victim protection, and youth support.

VIOLENCIA DOMÉSTICA Y DE GÉNERO

La violencia doméstica y de género es el comportamiento violento o agresivo en el hogar que, generalmente, implica maltrato de un cónyuge o pareja. Además, dicha violencia puede orientarse hacia la persona específicamente por su género. Los recursos de esta categoría están registrados como abuso infantil e incesto, grupos de apoyo y de terapia, servicios legales, violaciones y ataque sexual, protección de víctimas y apoyo para jóvenes.

家庭及性別暴力

家庭及性別暴力是指發生在家庭單位內的暴力或激進行為，多半涉及虐待配偶或伴侶。此外，此類暴力可能特別針對受虐方的性別所產生。此項目下的資源以虐待幼童及亂倫、團體諮詢及互助小組、法律服務、強暴及性侵、受虐者保護、及青少年協助等分項列舉。

ANTI-TRAFFICKING
