I. AFTER-SCHOOL PROGRAMS

After-School Programs provide childcare for elementary and middle school youth at hours when students are not in school and parents are not at home. They offer academic, social and recreational activities, and are sometimes referred to as “extended day” programs or “out-of-school-time” (OST). Resources in this category are listed under academic enrichment, arts and sports.

PROGRAMAS EXTRACURRICULARES

Los **programas extracurriculares** brindan cuidado infantil para los niños de primaria y escuela media cuando no están en la escuela y cuando sus padres no se encuentran en casa. Ofrecen actividades académicas, sociales y recreativas, y a veces se los nombra como programas “de día extendido” o “periodo fuera del horario escolar” (“out-of-school-time”, OST). Los recursos en esta categoría están listados bajo enriquecimiento académico, artes y deportes.

স্কুল ছুটি-পরবর্তী কর্মসূচি এলিমেন্টারি ও মিডল স্কুলের শিক্ষার্থীদের জন্য এমন সময়ে চাইল্ড কেয়ার প্রদান করে যখন শিক্ষার্থীরা স্কুলে থাকে না এবং পিতামাতারা বাসায় থাকেন না। তারা অ্যাকাডেমিক, সামাজিক ও বিনোদনমূলক কর্মকাণ্ড পরিচালনা করে, এবং এই কর্মসূচিকে কখনো কখনো “এক্সটেন্ডেড ডে” কর্মসূচি বা “আউট-অব-স্কুল-টাইম” (OST) হিসেবে উল্লেখ করা হয়। এই শ্রেণির তথ্য-উপকরণগুলোকে অ্যাকাডেমিক এনরিচমেন্ট, শিল্পকলা ও ক্রীড়ার অধীনে তালিকাভুক্ত করা হয়েছে।

II. DOMESTIC & GENDER-BASED VIOLENCE

DOMESTIC & GENDER-BASED VIOLENCE

Domestic and Gender-Based Violence is violent and/or aggressive behavior within the home, typically involving the abuse of a spouse or partner. This violence may be directed toward an individual specifically because of his/her gender. Resources in this category are listed under anti-trafficking, child abuse and incest, counseling and support groups, legal services, rape and sexual assault, stalking, victim protection and youth support.

VIOLENCIA DOMÉSTICA Y DE GÉNERO

La **violencia doméstica y de género** es el comportamiento violento y/o agresivo en el hogar que, generalmente, implica maltrato de un cónyuge o pareja. Dicha violencia puede orientarse hacia la persona debido a su género. Estos recursos están registrados como: abuso infantil e incesto, grupos de apoyo y de terapia, servicios legales, violaciones y ataque sexual, acecho, protección de víctimas y apoyo para jóvenes.

পারিবারিক ও লিঙ্গ-ভিত্তিক সহিংসতা

পারিবারিক ও লিঙ্গ-ভিত্তিক সহিংসতা হলো বাড়ির ভেতরে আগ্রাসী আচরণ, এর সাথে সাধারণত স্বামী/স্ত্রী বা পার্টনারের প্রতি নিগ্রহ জড়িত থাকে। কারো লিঙ্গের কারণে সেই ব্যক্তির প্রতি সুনির্দিষ্টভাবে এই সহিংসতা পরিচালিত হতে পারে। পাচার-প্রতিরোধ, শিশু নিগ্রহ ও অজাচার, কাউন্সেলিং ও সাপোর্ট গ্রুপ, আইনি পরিশেবা, ধর্ষণ ও যৌন হামলা, ক্রমাগত হয়রানি, ভিকটিম সুরক্ষা ও যুব সহায়তার অধীনে এই শ্রেণির তথ্য-উপকরণগুলো তালিকাভুক্ত করা হয়েছে।

III. EDUCATION FOR ADULTS

Education for Adults refers to programs that offer instruction in literacy, language, career-readiness and other trainings that will help adults live more successfully in their communities. Resources in this category are listed under computer literacy, Test Assessing Secondary Completion (TASC) preparation and transition to college.

EDUCACIÓN PARA ADULTOS

La **educación para adultos** hace referencia a programas que ofrecen instrucción para la alfabetización, el aprendizaje de un idioma, la preparación laboral, y otros tipos de formación que permiten que los adultos tengan una vida más exitosa en su comunidad. Los recursos de esta categoría se registran como alfabetización informática, preparación para el TASC (Prueba de Evaluación de haber completado la Secundaria) y transición a la universidad.

বয়স্ক শিক্ষা
