Julia Kagan Baumann is Senior Editor, Personal Finance and Retirement of Investopedia, the financial information website. She was the founding editor of *Target the Family* magazine for the Target Stores and was Editor of *Lamaze Parents* magazine, for whom she founded *LamazeBaby* magazine. She was the Visiting J. Stewart Riley Professor of Journalism at Indiana University and is a former Trustee of Bryn Mawr College. She is co-author of *Manworks: A Guide to Style* and a contributor to *The Working Woman Report* and the *Working Woman Success Book*. She won the National Magazine Award in Personal Service in 2003. In addition to the magazines where she worked, her articles have appeared in *Self*, *Allure* and *Genetic Engineering News*, among other publications. She is a former president of the Journalism and Woman Symposium and of the Rebecca Kelly Dance Company. She completed an MFA in creative nonfiction at Bennington Writing Seminars in 2012 and has her AB from Bryn Mawr College.
