Marge has been a member of the WCC for almost 20 years. She started as a Barbara Reach intern on the third research project about women's homeless shelters in NYC. She then joined the Women's Issues Committee and became Co-Chair and then Chair in 2003. Important issues for which the committee successfully advocated were paid sick days in NYC, paid family leave in NYS. She has been Co-Chair of the Task Force on Sexual Education in the NYC Public Schools, Co-Chair of the Education work group and Chair of the Criminal Justice work group at the Public Policy Committee (PPC). Marge served as WCC President from 2014-2015 and is currently a member of the Board.

Marge graduated from SUNY Purchase College with a degree in Women's Studies. While in college she interned at the DA's office on Domestic Violence in White Plains and at the Bedford Hills Correctional Institution. As a representative of the WCC she was one of the organizers of the first Walk to End Domestic Violence in NYC. She subsequently became a Board member and Treasurer.
